HS heading 0713 covers dried leguminous vegetables, shelled, whether or not skinned or split. Final tariff classification remains subject to the product form and destination requirements.

Red lentils - HS 0713.40

Canadian red lentils are widely traded in whole, football and split forms. Product form, grade, processing specification and tolerances are confirmed in the written quotation.

The red-orange colour is the cotyledon inside the seed coat. Whole product may be quoted using applicable Canadian grade language, while processed split product is supplied against an agreed contract specification.

Green lentils - HS 0713.40

Green lentils are commonly traded by class and size. Large green, medium green and small green programs are matched to the buyer's intended use and requested grade.

Size designation and quality parameters are confirmed for the selected lot. Final sieve, colour, damage and foreign material requirements form part of the written specification.

Specialty lentils serve premium retail, foodservice, canning and traditional cooking applications. Brown, black and French green-type programs are available subject to crop and supplier confirmation.

A lot-specific specification is issued against the buyer's required appearance, size, quality, packaging and destination documentation.

NAMING AND ORIGIN

SD Enterprises describes Saskatchewan-grown dark speckled product as French green-type lentils. It is not represented as Lentille verte du Puy. The final commercial description, origin and specification are stated in the quotation and shipping documents.

SPECIFICATION

Specialty classes are supplied against a written contract specification. Grade terminology, tolerances, crop year, quality parameters, packaging and certificate scope are confirmed for the selected supplier, facility and lot.

Kabuli chickpeas - HS 0713.20

Canadian Kabuli chickpeas are cream to light beige and commonly traded by commercial calibre. Calibre is a sizing specification and is confirmed separately from the grade.

Available programs may include 7 mm, 8 mm, 9 mm or agreed blends, subject to crop, supplier and lot availability.
